Application Project 1: Learning Retain 60 points	Chapter 1 Self-assessment application	A limited number of questions will include multiple-choice and T/F (20) Each student will write an essay discussing their individualized learning styles, learning and study strategies self assessments(50)
Application Project 2: Retain 60 points	Chapter 6,7 Memory Principles and application/mnemonics & Test Prep	Students will be asked to read a chapter assigned and identify and organize information for the purpose of creating study content and mnemonic devices to aid memory of content.
