RESEARCH AND SCHOLARLY ACTIVITY

APPLIED RESEARCH

My current research interests focus on social welfare policy, ethics, child welfare, commercial sexual exploitation of children (CSEC), and administrative and community practice. I am currently engaged in an interdisciplinary quantitative research project with faculty from the MSU Counseling program exploring the extent that clinical mental health providers were educated on burnout, compassion fatigue, and secondhand depression, assessing respondents' current knowledge around the topics and investigating how providers are battling burnout, compassion fatigue or secondhand depression symptoms. This project informs my approach to educating helping professionals to develop habits that will support personal and professional well-being throughout their careers and develop their ability to practice in a competent and ethical manner.

My dissertation topic explores the importance of the therapeutic alliance between a counselor and their client, Rogerian skills used by counselors in developing a therapeutic alliance with clients, special considerations for counselors working with CSEC Survivors, the usefulness of person-centered therapy to prepare survivors of child sex trafficking for further therapeutic intervention, and the need for further study regarding the use of a person-centered approach with CSEC survivors.

Previously I spent time working with faculty member from the MSU Texas Health Administration program to research student awareness and willingness to access campus sexual health resources and to identify barriers to student access of services.
