### A. Classrooms

- 1. Assigned seating will be used in all classes.
- 2. Attendance will be taken daily of students required to attend on that day.
- 3. Doorknobs will only be handled by the instructor.
- 4. Class will end a bit early.
- 5. Students will be given cleaning materials for their work area.
- 6. The faculty member will spray each work area.
- 7. At the end of class, students closest to the door will be given their materials first.
- 8. Once their area is cleaned, the student will dispose of the materials and exit.
- 9. Faculty members may request that the areas also be cleaned at the beginning of class.
- 10. No more than one student at a time is allowed in the short hallway outside B120.

## B. Scene Shop – Stage – Lighting/Sound Gear

- 1. The stage will not be used for audience performances.
- 2. The house seating will be roped off to ensure the least amount of contamination.
- 3. The student is to provide their own goggles, face masks, and work gloves.
- 4. Students will be wearing goggles, face masks, and work gloves at all times when working.
- 5. Disposable gloves are available in the shop.
- 6. Each student is responsible for any tools/materials they are using.
- 7. Only one student will be assigned to each of the stationary power tools at a time.
- 8. The student will disinfect the tool they are working on before they begin working with it.
- 9. When a tool is done being used, the student will disinfect it.
- 10. At the end of the workday, student assistants will gather and disinfect any remaining tools.

## C. Bea Wood Studio Theatre

- 1. The Studio has been stripped of all equipment to allow for socially distanced movement space.
- 2. No equipment, seats, risers, etc. will be permitted in this space. Acting exercise furniture is an exception and will be placed by instructor as needed.
- 3. The studio will not be used for audience performances.
- 4. THEA 2113 Movement I: Students will be required to have a Swiffer wet mop to clean their floor area both before and after use.
- 5. All directing exercises will be acted with masks while maintaining a six-foot distance between actors.

## D. Costume Shop

- 1. The first person in each day will disinfect doorknobs, light switches, machines, machine tables, plastic dividers, irons, phone, etc.
- 2. Each person will sanitize their machine and bobbins before beginning and ending work.

- 3. Each person will have their own box of scissors, seam ripper, hem gauge, etc. Only that person is to handle the box and any items in it.
- 4. Use hand sanitizer before touching any iron.
- 5. Hand sanitizer will be provided at every iron, by the door, on the cutting table and at entry into the serger room.
- 6. Everyone working in the Costume Shop is required to wear an appropriate face covering at all times. Anyone working on a costume for a production is required to wear nitrile or latex gloves while handling the costume. It is recommended that everyone wear nitrile or latex gloves at all times.

# E. Fitting Rooms

- 1. Social distancing is required. Only the person touching the actor can be within 6' of the actor.
- 2. Fittings will be held in dressing rooms and shower areas.
- 3. No more than 4 people (including the actor) may be at any fitting.
- 4. Safety pins will be kept in a large pin cushion and handled only by the person touching the actor.
- 5. The person touching the actor is required to wear nitrile or latex gloves.
- 6. Actors/costumers must sanitize their hands before and after a fitting.

# F. Dressing Rooms

- 1. Each actor will have their own makeup station.
- 2. There will be no more than one actor every third makeup station. This may mean that the number of actors in the dressing rooms will need to be staggered.
- 3. Some costumes will need to be hung in the hallways rather than the dressing rooms in order to ensure 6' between actors.
- 4. Actors are to bring personal suitcase/closed bag in which to put their street clothes while in costume.
- 5. Actors will use hand sanitizer every time they get up/return to their station.
- 6. Actors must supply their own hairbrushes, combs, etc.
- 7. The usual makeup safety guidelines will still be in place (no sharing, etc.).

# G. Greenroom

- 1. The Greenroom will remain locked and unavailable for student use during the pandemic. No exceptions.
- 2. Alpha Psi Omega officers who need access to the APO closet should request access by the sponsor. Only one officer allowed in the Greenroom at a time.
