AI being available in a Large Language Model form to the public is still new and changing quickly. It is something that had been on my radar before it was released and there was no formal AI-specific course at that time. I worked to understand what it is, how it works, and how we can exist with it in Higher Education. Hours of research and webinars about the technology we use on campus and off. This research was all centered around pedagogy principles, and how we redesign courses to strengthen Academic Integrity while understanding that Chat GPT isn't going away and employers will have an expectation that their employees know how to use it. In my position, I must understand AI Ethics and Governance, this is all moving at lightning speed and I have worked consistently to gain this knowledge as it became available. I've recently completed an AI Ethics and Governance course provided by D2L and INQ consulting. I'm familiar with the programs available to use AI, check for AI, paraphrase writing, and what AI writing looks like.

 collection of loans, I implemented a switch to a new loan servicer and system for the loan
 program which entailed uploading all paper documents into Image Now, and creating open
 communication with the Financial Aid office to work with students owing both Stafford and
 Perkins loans.
- Reconfigured third-party agreements To safeguard and guarantee these are up-to-date and all
 parties are made aware of and abiding by the same schedule, I created a new invoice template
 which was accepted by all agencies, this resulted in payments being received in a timely manner
 with minimum error and the ability to catch errors early.
- Participate and present at Orientation and First Year Seminar classes for new students to access and utilize their online portals.
- Train incoming employees and students to utilize the system and provide customer service to students regarding the portal.
- Participated in the 10-year SACSCOC Accreditation audit process, and passed all milestones.
