Research Participation

Women's Health Study, Brigham and Women's Hospital & Harvard Medical School. This landmark study (1993-2004) tested the benefits and risks of low-dose aspirin and vitamin E in the prevention of cardiovascular disease and cancer in women. During this 12 year period I took 3 pills a day, gave periodic blood samples and completed extensive quarterly health assessments. Although the randomized trial is completed, I continue to complete regular study questionnaires, to advance knowledge about the prevention of cardiovascular disease, cancer and other chronic diseases in women.

Applied Research

In 2009, I participated with a nursing team that studied the **Dalquest Desert Research Station** in south Texas to assess the health and safety hazards for students and faculty working at the site. From that assessment we formulated the Dalquest Desert Research Station Safety and Emergency Plan, and the online *Health Promotion and Injury Prevention Handbook* that deals with prevention, symptoms and first aid for 27 identified environmental hazards. http://academics.mwsu.edu/ddrs/handbook.asp?LL=253

As a follow-up to the Dalquest study, in 2016 our team again assessed the health and safety hazards at the research station in preparation for publication of the *Dalquest Desert Research Station Safety and Emergency Handbook* (see publications).

A research team from Texas Woman's University engaged in an ongoing environmental health research project to help save the Queen Conch from extinction by building a **Conch Refuge Ranch** on an island off the coast of Belize. In the summer of 2008 the coral reef was assessed. In the summer of 2009, five potential sites for the refuge were assessed on the island. The Ranch was constructed in 2011 and Queen Conch were collected, weighed and measured, tagged and aggregated in the Refuge Ranch to protect them from predators. They were to be reassessed annually for several breeding seasons and then returned to their natural environment. I presented this ongoing action research at a meeting of the National Science Teachers Association in San Francisco in the spring of 2011, and at the Hawaii University International Education, Technology and Mathematics Conference in Honolulu, in the summer of 2012.

To enhance the student experience for those taking **British Studies Public Health** — **Determinants of Health Disparities** in London in the summers of 2011, 2013, 2015, 2017, 2019, and 2022 I embarked on an applied research project to familiarize students with the city of London. London is so vast that without an organized approach they would not have time to appreciate all that the city has to offer. My research resulted in a booklet (updated annually) that

describes points of interest in the vicinity of each of our course venues so they could visit them while they were in the area. This allowed them to explore parts of the city on a daily basis to maximize their study abroad experience.
