Darla Diltz has garnered acclaim as an operatic soprano in a variety of repertoire including Donna Anna and Donna Elvira in Mozart's Don Giovanni, the title roles in both Lucia di Lammermoor and Suor Angelica with Knoxville Opera, Violetta in Verdi's La traviata, Pamina and First Lady in Mozart's Die Zauberflöte, Nella and Lauretta in Puccini's Gianni Schicchi, Gertrude in Humperdinck's Hansel and Gretel, Mimì and Musetta in Puccini's La bohème, Water in Rachel Portman's The Little Prince, Countess in Mozart's Le nozze di Figaro, Fiordiligi in Mozart's Così fan tutte, Tatyana in Tchaikovsky's Eugene Onegin, the title role in Puccini's Madama Butterfly, Tallulah Carter in Thomas Pasatieri's The Hotel Casablanca, Helena in Britten's A Midsummer Night's Dream, and Older Alyce in Tom Cipullo's Glory Denied.
