My dissertation explores the Home Economics Department archival collection from the Gee Library at TAMU-C. I primarily look at a sample of final exams left from home economics students who lived in the Home Management House between the years of 1936 and 1952. I argue that the home management house was a rhetorical space that increased rural women's agency while affording them the opportunity to build a specific type of literacy that I call, *domestic literacy*.
