Course goals

Read Shakespeare's *The Tempest* in our Arden book. For PowerPoints, each description paragraph describes a key moment in a scene. For the Essay, compare TWO of our films. Engage in a writing process that includes invention, drafting, and revision. Utilize credible supporting sources in our essays according to MLA citing. Demonstrate proficient use of Standard Written English.

In CONTENT, in the modules for DISCUSSION FORUM & TOPIC for a THREAD, click on the arrow next to the title of the discussion forum. Then click on VIEW TOPIC. Copy-and-paste or type directly into the text box. Don't use the attachment function (I am not able to reply to it). I can correct punctuation, syntax, and word choice errors. I can make my own edit of your paragraph. If you omitted or misunderstood something, I will alert you. This opportunity is called a THREAD, but this thread is very different from threads in other D2L courses. Our thread is NOT public. In your thread to me, no one can see your writing but me; likewise, you are the only one who can see my reply. NOTE: My help is purely optional. Plenty of people do well without my help beforehand. If you are truly interested in my help, post your thread to me in timely fashion. If you wait until the day before, or day of, the due date, I will reply, but it will be a brief remark.

Drop Box Due Dates: My replies to your threads are only for input. You still need to submit your assignment to the drop box in order for it to count and be graded.
