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I. TEXT: **HISTORY and HISTORIANS: A HISTORICAL INTRODUCTION**, by Mark T. Gilderhus

II. SCOPE OF CLASS: The Seminar will cover various types of history. These will include History as Romance; History as Science; History's Reaction to Science; History as Philosophy; Universal History; History as Psychology; Progressive History; and History by Vico; History as Identity; and Moral History

III. ORGANIZATION OF CLASS: First two weeks: comprehensive exam over text. Next four weeks: lecture based on topics by the professor over historiography. Next three weeks: assigned talks by the students; Final five weeks: additional lectures (Professor) and completion of term papers with oral critiques by the students.

IV. REQUIREMENTS:

- C. Group Discussion and oral critiques – 15%
