GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

Paper Components

- Title Page
- Introduction
- Review of Literature
- Conclusion
- References

APA Formatting Required

- 1-inch margins
- Calibri, 12-point font
- Double spaced

Body of Paper

- 10 pages of original work (no less, no more); this excludes the title page and reference page
- Citations should be provided for all information (citations should include the authors, date of publication)
- Quotes should be kept to a minimum (citations should also include page numbers for quotes)
- Subheadings should be used to organize the review
- Papers will be submitted to Turn-it-In to check for plagiarism and use of generative AI

Reference Page

- This page should be separate from the body of the paper
- Sources should be listed in alphabetical order
- Professional sources include academic journals, business/industry publications, and professional websites (such as the NCAA, AMA, CDC, etc.)
- Personal opinions, blogs, YouTube videos, non-academic websites, and news articles are generally not considered professional sources
- A minimum of 10 professional sources should be referenced and cited within the paper
- References should follow APA formatting guidelines
- Links to the source should be provided with each reference
