Teaching Responsibilities

ENGL Co-Req 0043/1143 - Integrated Reading and Writing (00430 and Writing and Academic Research: Provide instruction and practice in analyzing and evaluating Textual information and composing clear and logical text. These students do not meet the TSI readiness standard in reading, writing, or both. The second part I provide knowledge of rhetoric to make decisions about written communication. I engage them in writing thru a process of invention, drafting, and revision. They write arguments that provide strong support. They must find credible resources. They must write ethically, contextually, and appropriately and use MLA format. They must demonstrate proficient use of Standard Written English. The co-req, itself, is a challenge. *** I also taught it as two separate classes before the combination of co-req as 0043 and 1143.

ENGL 2113 Intermediate Composition and Grammar: to develop students' skills in clear and effective composition and standard usage of the English language.

ENGL 1003-Introduction to College Composition (developmental): the process and

practice of essay writing in preparation for the writing portion of THEA and ENGL 1113 and 1123.

ENGL 1013-Introduction to College Reading (developmental): the study and practice of reading comprehension in preparation for the reading portion of THEA and college level reading.

ENGL 1113-Rhetoric and Composition I: training in skills involved in the writing process through the composition of short essays, the reading of prose selections, and the practice of computer-assisted writing and editing.

ENGL 1014 – Integrated Reading and Writing: Analyze and evaluate textual information and compose clear and logical texts. This class is required for those who failed the reading and/or writing sections under the rules of TSI.

ENGL 2113 – Teaching skills that are clear and forceful in compositions and teaching other standard writing and grammar skills. This class is required for those who failed the WPE (writing proficiency exam).

ENGL 1123-Rhetoric and Composition II: continued training in skills involved in the writing process through composition and reading, thoughtful research of both print and electronic sources, and the preparation of a moderate length research paper.

IELI Intensive English Language Institute. Intensive teaching of grammar, reading, writing, and note-taking skills as well as listening and speaking skills. There are 6 levels of proficiency. These classes also allowed the opportunity for students to experience campus and American culture while engaging in these communicative language practices.
